Place of Writing:	Probably Corinth (Third Missionary Journey)

	he time of writing was named Gaius (16:23). Gaius is the name of a man at Corinth (I Cor 1:14).

	Il intended to go to Jerusalem and then to Rome (Acts 19:21; Rom 15:24-as going to Jerusalem to deliver money to the poor saints (Acts 24:17;
Date of Writing:	Between 55 and 57 A.D. (Gallio Inscription / 51 AD / Acts 18:12-18)
