(Genesis 39:1-12)

A. Providence (1-2)

"The LORD (YHWH) was with Joseph" (2) - This phrase occurs 4 times in chapter 39, and represents the theme of the story of Joseph

1. The Warden - "Captain of the Guard"

-Anyone working for Potiphar would be in a location where he would readily become aware of the ins and outs of Egyptian government.

2. The Work

-Joseph was humbled as a slave (Prov 15:33) but was in the house of Potiphar, which increased his opportunity to learn from him.

C. Proposition (7-12)

1. The Ways of Temptation

This is like a game film of Satan. It shows his favorite and most successful plays.

The temptation was...

Visual "Cast her eyes" (7) -Eve (**Gen 3:6**) -David (2Sam 11:2)

Versatile - Satan switches his temptation of Joseph from despair to delight. -Schemes (Eph 6:11)

Dignified or Disguised

-Coming from the master's wife made it sound more permissible and safer.

Timely "after a time" -This temptation came after Joseph was enjoying success (2Chr 26:15-16)

Persistent "day after day"

Deceitful "lie beside her"

Aggressive "caught him by his garment." (Acts 26:11) Joseph's position has changed significantly from the start of Chapter 37 to 39:

Now Joseph had been brought down to Egypt, and Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh, the captain of the guard, an Egyptian, had bought him from the Ishmaelites who had brought him down there. 2 The hard completing his new LORD was with Joseph, and he became a successful man, and he was in the house of his Egyptian master. 3 His master saw that the LORD was with him and that the LORD caused all that he did to succeed in his hands. 4 So Joseph found favor in his sight and attended him, and he made him overseer of his house and put him in charge of all that he had. 5 From the time that he made him overseer in his house and over all that he had, the LORD blessed the Egyptian's house for Joseph's sake; the blessing of the LORD was on all that he had, in house and field. 6 So he left all that he had in Joseph's charge, and because of him he had no concern about anything but the food he ate.

Now Joseph was handsome in form and appearance. 7 And after a time his master's wife cast her eyes on Joseph and said, "Lie with me." 8 But *he refused* and said to his master's wife, "Behold, because of me my master has no concern about anything in the house, and he has put everything that he has in my charge. 9 He is not greater in this house than I am, nor has he kept back anything from me except you, because you are his wife. How then can I do this great wickedness and sin against God?" 10 And as she spoke to Joseph day for Joseph's sake..." (5) after day, he would not listen to her, to lie beside her or to be with her.

¹¹ But one day, when he went into the house to do his work and none of the men of the house was there in the house, ¹² she caught him by his garment, saying, "Lie with me." But he left his garment in her hand and fled and got out of the house.

2. The War Against Temptation

1Cor 10:13 - No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it.
